Scheme

SCHEME MADE BY THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE
CHARITIES ACT, 1960.

The Foundation

1. In this Scheme, the expression "the Foundation" means Sir John Cass's Foundation, in the Parish of St. Botolph, Aldgate, in the Administrative County of London, regulated by a Scheme made under the Endowed Schools Acts on 11 May 1895, as altered by Schemes of the Charity Commissioners of 16 August 1901 and 18 September 1906, and by Schemes of the Board of Education of 22 August 1902, 21 December 1904, and 18 March 1907.

New School

2. (1) The Governors of the Foundation may, in such manner as the Minister of Education approves, establish and maintain at Stepney Way, Stepney, as a school of the Foundation to be called the Sir John Cass's Foundation and Red Coat Church of England Secondary School, a voluntary secondary school within the meaning of the Education Acts, 1944 to 1962, wherein religious instruction shall be given in accordance with the doctrines of the Church of England.

(2) For the purposes aforesaid, the Governors may -

(a) apply, under the authority of a further Order of the Minister of Education and subject to such conditions as to replacement as may be specified in that Order, capital moneys of the Foundation in or towards the purchase of a site and the erection, alteration or improvement of buildings for the said school; and

(b) apply so much of the income of the Foundation, as may be required in any year, in making grants for the purpose of enabling the Governors of the school to comply with their obligations under the Education Acts, 1944 to 1962.

Questions under Scheme

3. If any question arises as to the construction of this Scheme, or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme, it shall be determined by the Minister of Education upon such application made to him for the purpose as he thinks sufficient, and such determination shall be binding upon the Governors and all persons claiming under the Foundation.

Interpretation

4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Date of Scheme

5. The date of this Scheme shall be the day on which it is established by an Order of the Minister of Education.

The Minister of Education orders that the foregoing Scheme be established.
